# **PRESIDENT'S REPORT**

Hello fellow Women Owned Law (WOL) members and supporters! As I reflect upon the first full year of WOL's existence, I am amazed by and proud of all that we have accomplished in one year.

## HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE FIRST YEAR

- Within the first year of operation, over 175 members joined from over 20 states, as well as 1 member from Israel.
- We also have close to 90 sponsors, including 68 <u>Founders Circle Sponsors</u>, 19 <u>Founding</u> <u>Sponsors</u>, as well as 6 <u>in-kind sponsors</u>.
- We have <u>regional presences</u> in 18 locations, and have hosted events in Philadelphia, Southern New Jersey, D.C., New York City, Chicago, Dallas and Kentucky.
- We launched the monthly <u>WOL Virtual Speaker Series Webinars</u> on various business-related topics of interest to our members.
- Our marketing and communications efforts included launching our new logo and brand, Members and Sponsor badges and a new <u>website</u>, which includes a membership directory, jobs board, externally facing <u>"professional directory,"</u> and internal communication systems for our members and teams.
- We hired our first employee, Director of Operations, Amy Danziger Shapiro, Esq.
- We commenced our strategic planning process, including a survey, several focus groups, a day-long leadership retreat, and launched the process to draft our strategic plan for the next three years.
- We refined our infrastructure, introducing several new <u>committees</u> and a Diversity & Inclusion initiative chaired by Advisory Board members Virginia Essandoh and Sheryl Axelrod.
- We have added over ten <u>member benefits</u> in partnership with our members and sponsors, with more on the way.
- We have initiated several partnerships with like-minded organizations including Jenkins Law Library, the University of Pennsylvania Law School, the Pyramid Club, Ellevate, Her Corner, Tory Burch Foundation, Select Counsel, and others, to bring opportunities and added value to our members.
- We have a number of success stories this year, including new law firms that have launched with the support of WOL and business referred among WOL members.

Well, it's been quite a year!! None of this could be possible without all of your support, and most especially the support of our members, sponsors and all of our amazing and devoted volunteers, including our Board of Directors, who spent countless hours over the last year on all of our initiatives.



## **Looking Forward**

Looking forward, we are continuing our work to further develop WOL into a robust resource and platform for our members and other women entrepreneurs in the law. Here is a peek at what to expect in 2018.

- On March 1, 2018, we launched a new <u>membership</u> and <u>sponsorship</u> structure that better fits the needs of our members and sponsors, as well as the needs of WOL as we move into our second year of existence. Member renewals will begin in March. In recognition of the faith that our members who joined in early 2017 placed in us, we have extended their member year by two months. Thus, the first renewal notice should be received starting March 15, 2018.
- We are hosting our first Annual Meeting of Members in where we will elect several new Directors to the Board and we have added several new members to our Advisory Board. These fantastic new additions not only add value and strength to the WOL leadership but also demonstrate WOL's commitment to diversity and inclusion. We anticipate continuing to add new Board and Advisory Board members in the coming year.
- We will continue to grow our member and sponsor base, especially in new regions, including internationally.
- We will be conducting a member survey to learn more about our members, to hear about their experiences to date with WOL and to get feedback on new benefits and initiatives they would like to see as WOL moves forward.
- We will continue to host events in our local regions the <u>events calendar</u> represents a robust first half of 2018, with numerous events planned in Philadelphia, Southern New Jersey, New York City, Buffalo, NY, D.C., Chicago and more expected in other regions. We also anticipate adding to our regional representatives in new regions.
- We will continue our <u>webinar series</u> we have webinars planned through May 2018 so checkout our <u>calendar</u> for details. We are also delighted to announce that Jennifer Lynn Robinson, Esquire, CEO of Purposeful Networking, has agreed to serve as our Virtual Speaker Series Program Chair. Jennifer is already hard at work planning the webinars for the balance of 2018.
- We are continuing our strategic planning process, which will culminate in a formal strategic plan that should be ready to share with members by this summer.
- We expect to launch several new initiatives this year in accordance with our mission, vision and strategic plan, including a WOL Newsletter (which will have the opportunity for member-provided content), the long-awaited WOLStat research project and opportunities to connect with prospective clients and referral partners.

Being a WOL member has proved to be very beneficial and I encourage you to <u>get involved</u>! Come to our <u>events</u>, volunteer to serve on one of our <u>committees</u> (local or national) or on our Diversity & Inclusion Task Force, update your <u>member profile</u> in our directory and use our <u>directory</u> to connect with and refer work to other WOL members, use our <u>job board</u>, and other <u>member benefits</u>, join the dialogue on our social media, and create communities in the member-

# TREASURER'S REPORT

## **Financial Statement**

Upon commencement of operations in January 2017, WOL had no members, no financial infrastructure (bank accounts or insurance), no budget and no assets. By building its membership, program

offerings and sponsorship opportunities, and with the help of many generous and dedicated volunteers, our revenues for the year exceeded \$50,000. We begin the 2018 fiscal year with a budget that includes clear benchmarks, cash in the bank, a solid infrastructure and the ability to grow.

## **Financial Highlights**

- Opened and managed all accounts
- Secured insurance
- Managed finances, including bookkeeping, disbursements, and projections
- Maintained positive cash flow and built some reserve.
- Created and passed a 2018 budget (attached as separate document) forecasting income and expenses by committee, and category.

## **Financial Analysis and Forecast**

Starting a new organization is financially challenging and for WOL this was no exception. We had no history with which to predict how many members would join and how much income we could earn. We were also unable to predict what resources we would need. Also, everything had to be built from scratch, initially with volunteer resources only. Accordingly, in 2017, we carefully scrutinized all of our expenses, and closely monitored our financial status, to ensure that we grew as needed, within our available budget. We were careful to leave a significant reserve at the end of the year, as this will be our first year with membership renewals and we need to ensure the financial stability of the organization.

Given our size and relative early stage, in 2018, WOL will need to continue to carefully and frequently manage its finances, as we continue to grow.
